เรื่อง ขอเชิญเข้าร่วมงานเสวนา Policy Innovation Exchange (PIX) ครั้งที่ ๔

ด้วย สำนักงานสภาพัฒนาการเศรษฐกิจและสังคมแห่งชาติ และโครงการพัฒนาแห่ง สหประชาชาติประจำประเทศไทย (UNDP) ได้ดำเนินการพัฒนาห้องปฏิบัติการนโยบายประเทศไทย (Thailand Policy Lab) โดยมีวัตถุประสงค์เพื่อเป็นพื้นที่ในการสำรวจ พัฒนา และทดลองแนวทางการแก้ปัญหา ที่เกิดจาก กระบวนการการมีส่วนร่วมของผู้เกี่ยวข้องทั้งภาครัฐ ภาคเอกชน ประชาชน รวมถึงปรับเปลี่ยนกระบวนการ ออกแบบนโยบายสาธารณะให้สามารถแก้ไขปัญหาที่มีความซับซ้อนได้อย่างเป็นระบบ ตอบโจทย์ความต้องการ ของประชาชน และเท่าทันความท้าทาย โดยที่ผ่านมาได้มีการจัดงานเสวนา Policy Innovation Exchange (PIX) มาแล้ว ๓ ครั้ง ได้แก่ ครั้งที่ ๑ หัวข้อ 'Where Inclusive Policymaking Meets Innovation' ครั้งที่ ๒ หัวข้อ 'เส้นทางพลิกโฉมอนาคต ๕ ประเทศ (Transformation Journeys)' และครั้งที่ ๓ หัวข้อ 'คิดนโยบายแนวใหม่ ในโลกที่ซับซ้อน: แนวคิดเชิงระบบ และประชาชนเป็นศูนย์กลาง (Reimagine Policymaking: Systems Approach and People-Centered Design)' ซึ่งมีผู้เข้าร่วมงานจำนวนมาก

POLICY INNOVATION EXCHANGE 4 (PIX4)

As an upper-middle-income country, Thailand has the capacity and expertise to address many of the basic development challenges affecting developing nations. However, several challenges remain. COVID-19 pandemic revealed vulnerabilities and weaknesses in some public policies and ability to deliver services. The response to the pandemic, as well as the need to accelerate progress towards Thailand's development objectives, including the Sustainable Development Goals, highlights that traditional or "business-as-usual" approaches for designing and formulating policy and delivering public services are increasingly less relevant, lacking agility and how both efficiency and effectiveness need to be further improved to deliver expected impact.

To address complex development challenges in Thailand, the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the Royal Thai Government through the Office of National Economic and Social Development Council (NESDC) have partnered to establish the Thailand Policy Lab. The Thailand Policy Lab seeks to identify paradigm shifts emerging from the current response of the Royal Thai Government to current challenges. It asks which new models of governance can enable better preparedness for future crises and the achievement of the Sustainable

Development Goals (SDG) in Thailand and identifies interventions that are grounded in system-thinking and can accelerate the transition from short-term to long-term policy and planning. To address the challenges, the Thailand Policy Lab enhances the capacity of the Royal Thai Government in terms of knowledge, skills and hands-on experience in applying policy innovation in policy formulation, implementation and evaluation; share good practices and experience on policy innovations; and be a learning platform for a community of innovators - by developing knowledge products to expand knowledge of innovations and its contribution to SDGs among various stakeholders such as experts, decision-makers, government agencies, local administrative organizations, civil society organizations, academia, private sectors, social enterprises, etc.

Recognizing the importance of facilitating the use of innovative tools, processes, and technologies in policymaking, the Policy Innovation Exchange 4 (PIX4) will be hosted by the Thailand Policy Lab (TPLab).

PIX4 aims to facilitate the cross-border exchange of strategies, practices, and lessons learned in the realm of policy innovation, particularly concerning the 'transformation of policymaking through innovative approaches and inclusivity.' The knowledge-exchange forum is designed around the principles in policymaking upheld by the Thailand Policy Lab: Public Policy Process Reimagined 8 Elements in Action, including Systems Thinking, Humanistic Approach, Inclusive Participation, Learning Oriented and Action Oriented Approaches. Additionally, it seeks to showcase and share case studies from the Thailand Policy Lab with stakeholders at the sub-national, national, and international levels, as well as to serve as a public platform for policy design, from which insights will inform the Thailand Policy Lab's policy design projects.

PIX4's specific objectives are to:

- Strengthen the position of the Thailand Policy Lab as a catalyst for policymaking transformation through innovative approaches among the governments and related sectors in policymaking ecosystem at the national and global levels.
- Raise awareness of the importance of policy innovation that can enable Thailand to escape the middle-income trap and accelerate progress towards the Sustainable Development Goals.
- Promote the concept of the Public Policy Process Reimagined 8 Elements in Action, including Systems Thinking, Humanistic Approach, Inclusive Participation, Learning Oriented and Action Oriented Approaches, in accordance with innovative tools and processes that can enhance this practice.
- Ensure policy-makers in Thailand have access to updated information and knowledge on policy innovation, practices and lessons learned in Thailand including from the Thailand Policy Lab, and other countries.
- Introduce and share innovative tools and/or processes currently being implemented in policymaking processes and public engagement in the global arena by various organizations.
- Enhance a community of innovators by bringing together experts and policy makers to share their knowledge, experiences, lessons learned and discuss the policy making transformation journey in different countries.
- Facilitate a space for people-centered policy design, the insights from which will feed into the Thailand Policy Lab's policy design projects.

PIX 4 will be a hybrid event (online and offline). It is expected that this event will be attended online by approximately over 1,000 Thai and regional participants who are government officials, policymakers, policy designers, educators, non-governmental organizations (NGO) and private-sectors companies and up to 300 participants for the physical event. The event will also be opened to the public for registration.


